As writers, we will be exploring the story of Bob, Man on the Moon. We will explore the characters and write our own Man on the moon adventure. We will then look at other alien and space stories and try to use common vocabulary in our own "Space Stories". Having an awe and wonder about the various scientific concepts.

As explorers, we will be studying the 'Space Race' and focusing on Neil Armstrong and the Moon landing. We will also continue to explore the seasons, as well as weather and temperature. Questioning the world and the environment.

In PE, we will be improving our athletic skills of throwing and striking a ball in game setting. PE is on Mondays and Thursdays. Understanding failure and disappointment as well as success and joy.

Our Christian Value this term is Forgiveness.

As scientists, we will be observing seasonal change as well as the science of space. We will also be working scientifically by designing and carrying out some simple experiments. Having aspirations through inspiration in books and text.



## Our Learning Questions:

In Music, we will be listening to Space music and creating space themed music of our own. Communication and working with others.

As artists and designers, we will be creating "Space Themed" print, using our own designs.

We will also participate in lots of cross curricular art around our topic of aliens and space focusing on line and shape. In DT we will try to make some Space Rock Cakes! Understanding how art can have an emotional impact on the beholder.

In RE we will be finding out 'What is the 'good news' Christians believe Jesus brings? Understanding other cultures, opinions, values and points of views.

At the end of term, we hope to be holding a special 'Space Day'!
