Books – a mix of adult and child choice!
 Children choose the end of day story to help them explore their likes
 Adult chosen books:
Frog & Toad – The List, The Garden, Dragons & Giants, Anywhere Farm, The Tree, Mad About Minibeasts, Jack & the Beanstalk
 Recapping and continuing our phonic sounds using jolly Phonics songs & actions, and Tricky Words songs
 Developing sentence writing challenges around our learning theme!

Communication & Language

Regular carpet talking and sharing time, and games that develop language awareness
 After taking our class bear, Billie, home for a weekend, children have the opportunity to tell the class what they did
 Stories and circle time with lots of chances to talk – as a class and within groups
 Lots of time for child initiated interaction

Mathematics



Recapping subtraction, addition, number bond 10 skills
 Learning all about the properties 2D 'flat' and 3D 'fat' shapes
 Learning about doubling and sharing into groups
 Counting beyond 20
 Spotting patterns in numbers including odds and evens

Religious Education

This term's value is: Forgiveness
 The children follow learning about Christians belief and God with Tessa and Tom, around the theme of forgiveness.
