

Behaviour and Relationship Policy addendum – School reopening Covid 19 (June 2020)

All staff and children are expected to continue to follow our school's Golden Rules:

We are gentle.

We are kind and helpful.

We listen.

We are honest.

We work hard.

We look after property.

Staff will use positive language, noticing and praising children when they follow the rules, e.g.

'Thank you for keeping your distance from me. That helps keep us both safe.'

'Remember that we need to wash our hands again to keep us all safe.'

'Remember that to keep us all safe we need to cough or sneeze into a tissue, bin the tissue and then wash hands.'

Children will be reminded frequently to:

Social distance as much as possible. They should aim to stay far enough away that they cannot touch anyone else with their outstretched arms,

Wash their hands for 20 seconds.

Follow respiratory hygiene guidance: Catch it, bin it, kill it. Cough or sneeze into your elbow if you do not have a tissue. Always wash hands after coughing or sneezing.

Keep their hands away from their mouths and noses.

Tell an adult if they are feeling poorly.

Avoid sharing equipment.

Use the toilets sensibly. Do not stop and chat to anyone else using the toilets.

Not bring in toys or other items from home.
