As mathematicians, we will begin by consolidating our place value knowledge and then using this in problems involving money. We will then be working on the four mathematical operations.

As artists and designers, we will be creating our own 'Seascapes' using watercolours and collage materials based on the work of Louise Brooks - a local artist from Brighton. In DT we will be using tools correctly to make food for a picnic.

As explorers, we will be comparing seaside holidays in the past to now. We will be looking at what was different and what has stayed the same. We will compare the seaside in another country. We will also be improving our geographical vocabulary.
