

As mathematicians, we will be organising information on pictograms, bar charts, tables and line graphs and interpreting statistics. We will also be exploring properties of shapes looking at angles, as well as parallel and perpendicular lines. We will be exploring 3D shapes, lines of symmetry and using coordinates to plot objects/ shapes on a grid and their movement.
